



CABERNET SAUVIGNON DE PURCARI

Organoleptic characteristics: dry red wine - intense ruby color, with violet reflections and a rich aroma, dominated by black cherries, complemented over time by fine notes of exotic spices.

The taste is full, complex, with notes of ripe fruit, chocolate, vanilla and raisins. The soft tannins underline its roundness and softness up to the long aftertaste, with nuances of maturation Aged for 6 months in French oak barriques.

The recommended temperature for consumption is: +18/ +20 °C. Pairings: table wine with appetizers of fresh cured meats, first courses based on lamb or beef, especially beef fillet in Gorgonzola sauce and generous platters of blue cheeses.
